<u>Communication on Course:</u> President Gibson will be purchasing the 10 Headsets not to exceed \$300, as previously approved by the board. John Jones has been researching communication apps for use on course.

IFGS Presentation: Presentation for new IFGS classes and safety speech is still being worked on by David Spence, he will send completed presentations to board members for review by next meeting.

<u>Resuming in person Games 1108</u>: Currently 50% of eligible populations have not received vaccine. Safety officer stated currently at 3000 new cases reported per day. Recommends waiting until around 1000 cases per day for full opening. Safety officer says earliest would be possibly June but is leaning towards July. Board will need to purchase a good quality No-Touch Thermometer to perform temperature screenings. Masks will need to be required in all enclosed spaces. Possible June "soft opening Invite only game" with bar game and clean-up of course or weapons building.

<u>Proposal to begin an advertisement campaign:</u> David Spence mentions that our average number of players is decreased significantly since 2016. He proposes to start advertising again once games start to bring involvement up.
