Committee Reports:

(NOTE: This date is a target ONLY. We will NOT have a firm game date until the game has been sanctioned. But that is the date I'm shooting for.)

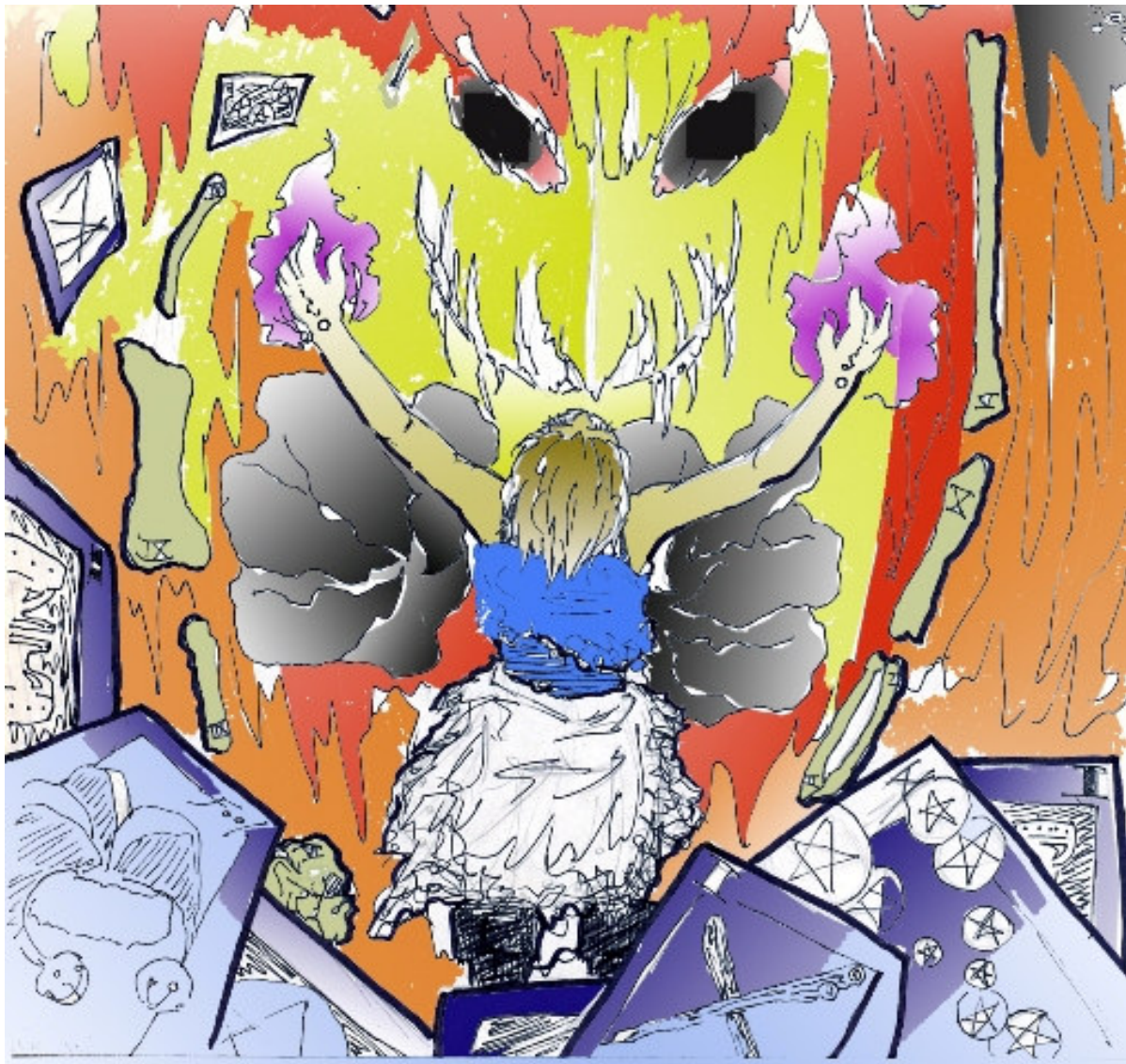
