Approval of minutes: The July/August and September minutes were approved with a 6:0 vote.

Committee Reports:

*Treasury* – Completely caught up and good.

*Quartermaster* - John Jones - The shed needs to be cleaned but with all of the volunteers here, this should be easily fixed.

*Registry* – Olan Knight - Still doing paperwork for Samurai Pirate, but all games up to that point are up to date.

*Safety* – Rich Adkisson The 5<sup>th</sup> radio was found and returned home after a short adventure of its own. In relations to the need for more working radios, Rich say that he has some big ones but they need batteries. It might be cheaper to get more radios so that will be looked into by Rich. Rich is to look into new radios and will email a comparison list before the game on the 19<sup>th</sup> and the board will decide on the 19<sup>th</sup> at Aftermath.

New Business

Attendance to board meetings by board members: A desire to try and instigate a suggested attendance quota for board member around 75% was brought up. The chapter constitution will be examined to see what we can be done for current board members who have not met that expectation to see if their earned cap will be prorated to fit the attendance.

*Olan Knight, speaking as the Society Registry Chair, said that such a rule is already in place. Board members who do not attend every official Board Meeting will automatically have their Administrative CAP reduced by an appropriate percentage, but the Chapter Board can vote to override this penalty if they choose to do so.*

\*For people who want to be on the board for the 2012 year, please take into consideration that you will be expected to attend **at least 75%** of the monthly board meetings.
