## Much has happened in the last week....

1) At A-Kon this year, the "Fight The Knight" event has been replaced with a 10-minute mini-game called "In The Name Of The Sun". This is designed to give people the flavor of playing in an IFGS-style line course game. It will include stepping stones, lock picking, a single fight, and rescuing a prisoner. We still need people to help run this event, and the great news is that it will not be three straight hours of combat! So come one, come all to help out.

The game starts at anywhere from 3 - 3:15, depending on how long it takes to get set up, and the people participating will need to arrive at least 5 minutes early to get briefed on the classes and given basic weapons and safety training. Teams will consist of [2 A-Kon attendees + 1 IFGS member].

In addition, it would be great if some of us were on hand during the day to busk for people to sign-up for the mini-game - much like we do at AnimeFest. Once set up, we figure we can run 5-6 teams an hour through the course, and we can have 2 teams on course at the same time. We will be looking for a central location where the buskers can set up as a base that is outside the dealer's room once we get to A-Kon. If that cannot be arranged, the buskers can use the Knighthawk Armoury booth as a base; the only drawback to plan B is that you will need a badge to get into the Dealer's Room.

2) The "Tarrelaine Weapons & Instruction Tournament" will be running on 21-JUN-2014. This is to give anyone from A-Kon who has decided to try the IFGS an opportunity to participate in an event with minimal risk, and to get trained in IFGS-style combat.

3) "Caravan" will run on 19-JUL-2014 to give low level PCs, and most importantly any newbies from A-Kon, a line course game in which to play.

4) The mini-game for AnimeFest is up in the air. We've run both Forged and Re-Forged several times, so we're not sure if we should start over with Midnight Shuffle again or run a new game? If someone would like to write a one-hour mini-game for AnimeFest, please let me (Olan Knight - [olknight@yahoo.com](mailto:olknight@yahoo.com)) know as soon as possible.

5) "Wet Behind the Ears" will be running on August 30, 2014 at Winter Park in Garland, TX. This is being run specifically for newbies from AnimeFest, as well as for low level PCs that have not had an opportunity to play in a while. The flyer is attached.

6) FYI: We will be handling waivers in a different manner from this point on. David Spence is rewriting the Waivers, both the under 18 and the over 18 versions. Once read and signed, these waivers will be kept on file and be valid for one calendar year. Note that each member's IFGS Waiver Status will be available online once everything gets put into place. The plan is for the new Waivers to be in effect at A-Kon this year.

Due to this event occurring after Anime Fest, it is required for each LM to leave at least two slots available on their team for newbies until after the convention.

Background lore will be sent to the Loremasters to provide to their teams at their discretion.

**Fighting: 6**

**Physical: 5**

**Mental: 6**

**Risk: 6**

This is a game designed for more role-playing oriented characters. Although there will be no issue with bringing "hack and slash" characters as they will still be able to achieve all game objectives, players may find the game much more enjoyable to bring characters that prefer NPC interaction.

Date: August 30<sup>th</sup> at Cecil B. Winters Park in Garland. The first team is expected to start at around 10:00 am. Additional teams will be staggered in about 30-45 minute increments. Please show up at least one hour before your expected start time. NPCs, please show up no later than 9:00 am.

**Game Fee: \$15 PC, \$5 NPC**

Fate Point Option IS in Effect.

No other variant rules are in effect except for those specific to the game.
