Playtest: A Game .. Card Game

Taking inspiration from Blackjack (the game) I decided to create a card game for the followers of the Don. Naturally, the number 7 plays the primary role.

Object: Beat the dealer in drawing cards equal to the number 7 or to draw the 7 (a Natural) on the first round

Betting: A bet is placed at the start of the game. Beating the dealer results in the bet being doubled. Beating the dealer with a natural results in the bet being multiplied by 5.

Rules: Cards are valued from 1 to 13. Ace, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, Jack, Queen, King The deck is comprised of 4 card decks but only 4 sevens are included.

Round 1: The dealer deals one card face up to each player clockwise and then finally, one to himself face up. If the first card is a 7, the Don smile upon you and you win.

Round 2: Dealer deals the cards starting with himself. (House has the edge). If he reaches 7 first, he wins, play stops, and bets are collected.

A card is dealt to each player. If the card from round 1 was below 7, this subsequent card is added to the first card. If the card from round 1 was above 7, this subsequent card is subtracted from the first card. If a player reaches 7 first, he wins, play stops, bets are paid out.

Round 3: Dealer starts the next round by dealing a card to himself. I If he reaches 7 first, he wins, play stops, and bets are collected.

A card is dealt to each player. If the card from round 2 was below 7, this subsequent card is added to the total of first and second card. If the card from round 2 was above 7, this subsequent card is subtracted from the total of the first card and second card. If a player reaches 7 first, he wins, play stops, bets are paid out.

If the dealer or a player receive a 7 during a round other than the first, they earned the Don's favor but must earn it by questing. The seven is placed to the side all all subsequent card draws are applied to take the hand to zero.

Conclusion: Play continues until someone has a card total that equals 7 or they have drawn a 7 and completed the quest to reduce their card total to zero.

I humbly request that someone playtest this card game and provide feedaback or suggest changes. I can forsee a game that never ends and I'd welcome feedback as to things that would make it more fun.
