

Gozer (Henry Wood) was sponsoring a tournament on the isle of Rabina. There was a contest of Fighting Prowess that was won by Einkyl ShieldClash (Greyson Cox). A Puegelsdam tournament was held where two people tried to knock each other off of a log and that was also won by Einkyl. A tournament of the mind was held where people had to figure out chess problems and that was won by Stealin (David Gibson). A contest of dexterity and lock picking was held that was won by Kei (Sarah Gibson) and finally a test of cunning won by Temper the Tiefling. I guess what they say about the devilish is true in her case.

Once the winners were determined they set off to fight a Wendigo that was terrorizing the area. Thanks to the makeup crew that made up Dustin Proctor it was a truly terrifying encounter.
